2021 Scholarship Program

The **Fondation Lucien-Piché** is a non-profit charitable organization that was created in 1987 after the passing of Professor Lucien Piché, a chemistry Professor who was the first secular person to occupy a Vice-President position at the Université de Montréal. The Foundation's mission is to encourage undergraduate chemistry students from Québec universities by awarding merit scholarships. The Foundation is managed by a board of directors composed of university Professors, researchers and professionals from the field of chemistry. All members of the board of directors are volunteers. The funds raised and administered by the Fondation are entirely used to support students via scholarships and to cover the operation and maintenance costs. Since its creation in 1987, the Fondation Lucien-Piché awarded close to 120 scholarships for a total of more than 120,000\$. Many of our awardees now occupy leading positions in academia and industry in the province of Québec and abroad. The Fondation is sponsored by 10 companies that are based in Quebec, Canada and USA operating in various fields of chemistry.
